I write to inform you of the changes in our amended motion for partial summary judgment, filed today, December 21, 2010.

We added one ground for summary judgment and supporting argument reflecting the Schofield decision, issued after our motion was filed, on pages 8, 16, 18, 34-36, 46, 50-51, and 77-80. On pages 3, 8, 13, 15, 52, 55, and 71 we incorporate two supplemental exhibits.
